Founded in 2009 by owner and waterman Bill Price, Head High Wines is the first verified Climate Neutral - Ocean Positive wine brand. We strive to be one of the most environmentally conscious wine brands in the world and are responsible stewards of the land in all that we do.

SUSTAINABLE SURF

Sustainable Surf protects and restores ocean health by encouraging people to shift to a low-carbon lifestyle with an emphasis on using ocean-friendly materials, ending plastic pollution, and restoring coastal ecosystems. As the first Ocean Positive wine brand, we offset our carbon footprint through rebuilding kelp forests, watersheds and mangroves throughout the world. Every year, Head High supports social and environmental organizations through SeaTrees by Sustainable Surf that make the land and sea healthier. SeaTrees directly supports communities and scientists who protect and regenerate blue carbon coastal ecosystems, which can be up to 5-10x more effective than rainforest at removing carbon from the air.

TASTING NOTES

We source 100 percent of our fruit from our home base of Sonoma County. The goal in every bottle of Head High is to properly express the diversity of our growing region. We are very intentional in clonal selections to best structure full body and unique wines. Our winemaking philosophy is purposefully minimal to allow the fruit Sonoma County produces to shine. This Pinot Noir is aromatic of warming spice, wooded earth, and kirsch. The palate is tangy with red plum, incense and cola.

Pairs well with pizza with spicy sausage, grilled pork chop with sautéed vegetables or sharp cheeses.
